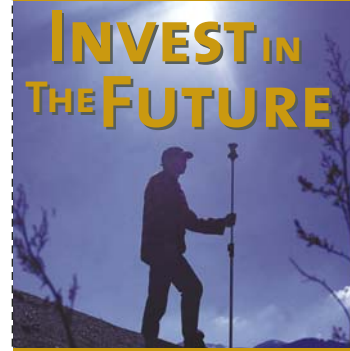

# ABOUT THE AOLS EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

Since the first township was surveyed in 1783, land surveyors have played a major role in the settlement and development of land in Ontario. In 1892, the Association of Ontario Land Surveyors (AOLS) was established to form a self-regulating professional body that would serve the common interests of its members and provide protection for the public. Over the past century, more than 1800 men and women have been proudly sworn in as licensed Ontario Land Surveyors and almost 200 have been sworn in and hold a Certificate of Registration in Geographic Information Management, Geodesy, Hydrography or Photogrammetry.

The AOLS Educational Foundation is a registered charity (13456 8161) that was founded in 1973 to: *“...receive and maintain a fund...for educational and charitable purposes within the Province of Ontario.”*

The fund began with a \$5000 donation from Jack Barnes, OLS through his company J. D. Barnes Limited. Jack felt that tangible evidence of practitioners’ support for independent programs and surveying education would be manifested if annual scholarships or bursaries were established. The first awards were presented in 1975 to Paul Miller and Jim Statham, who were both students in Survey Science at Erindale College, University of Toronto.

The Educational Foundation’s goal is to raise the capital fund from the current \$220,000 to \$500,000. This would allow up to \$20,000 to be awarded each year to post-secondary Geomatics students who have attained high academic achievement and possess evident characteristics of leadership and professionalism. These awards play a significant role in attracting promising students to the Association.

Since 1975, the AOLS Educational Foundation has presented academic awards totaling more than \$150,000 to more than one hundred and forty students in various Geomatics programs. A considerable number of the award recipients were subsequently sworn in as Ontario Land Surveyors.
