




#### **Q2 Category of Registration for AGM**





#### Q3 Age







## Q5 How would you rate the conference facilities for the meeting?





#### Q6 How would you rate the meals?








## Q9 How do you prefer the room to be set up?

### Q14 Did you have enough time to visit the exhibits?



### Q15 How many of the 9 vendor sessions did you attend?






