I/we would like to suggest that if another Party Chief Seminar is being contemplated, then a key component of that Seminar (or maybe one done on it's own) should deal with field notes. Prior to the electronic collection of data associated with the field work, the Party Chief and crew were responsible for the recording of clear and proper field notes, which would have been done clearly enough to stand on their own, without the need for any explanation. They would illustrate all of the evidence found during the course of the survey, and also illustrate the methodology that was used in the decision making process. Quite often the Courts would have viewed the field notes as the best evidence of the survey, in support of the final decisions that were shown on the final Plan.
