

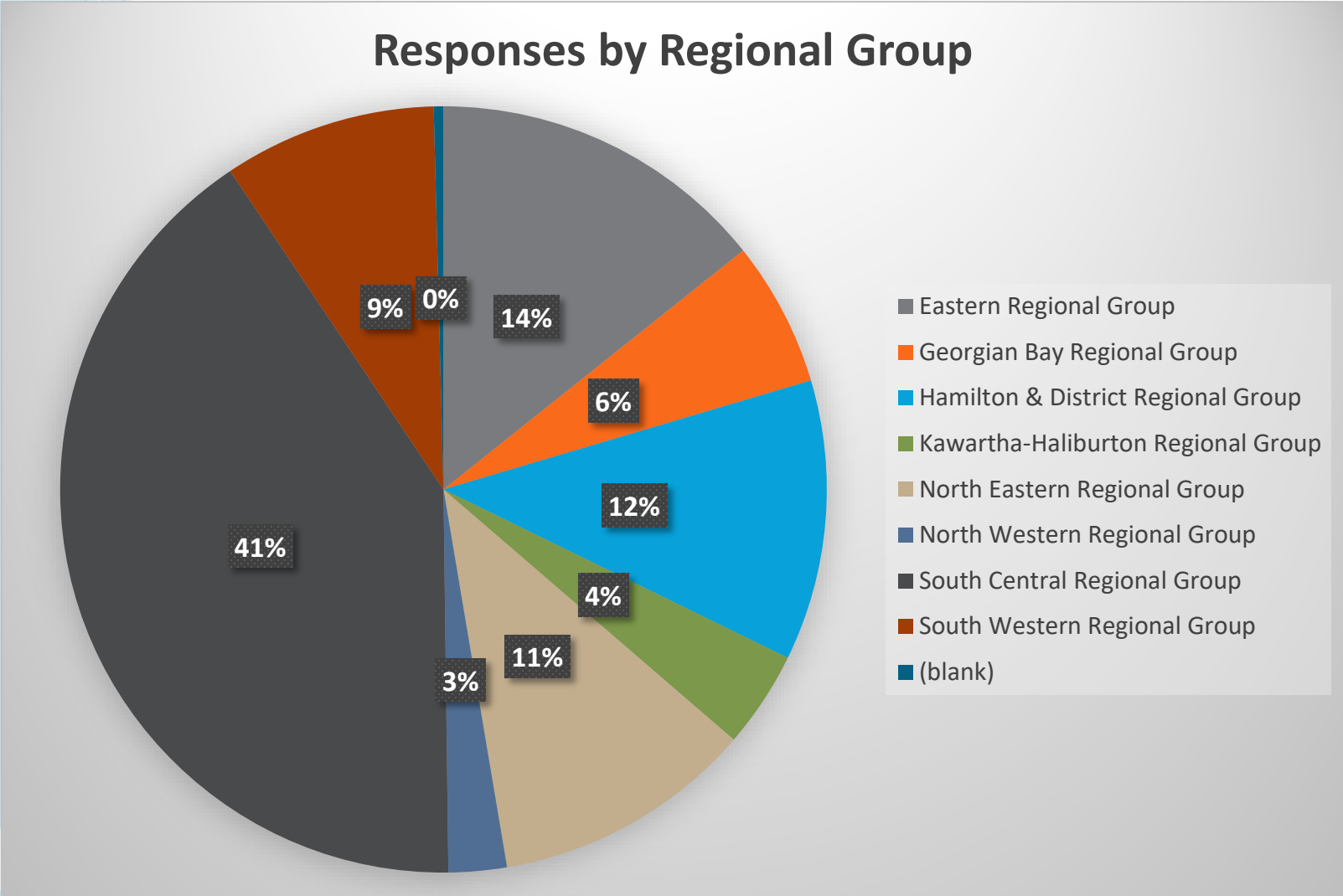

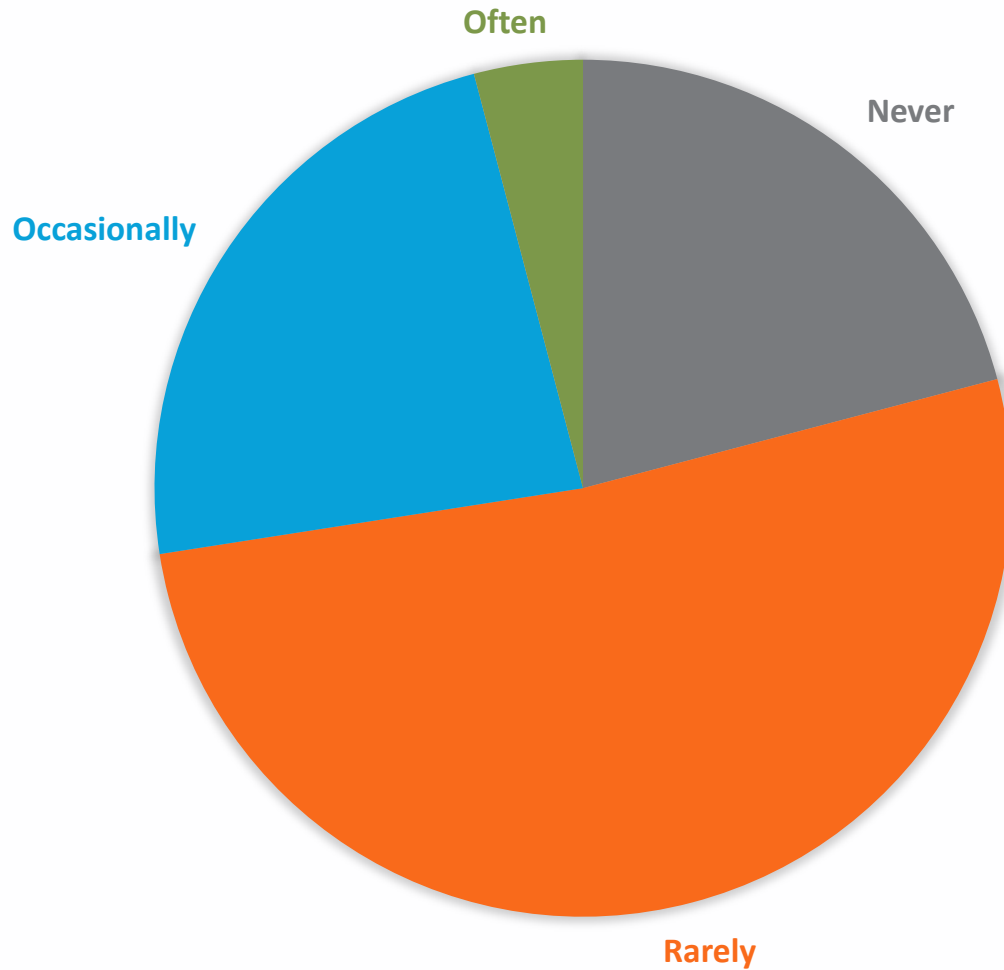

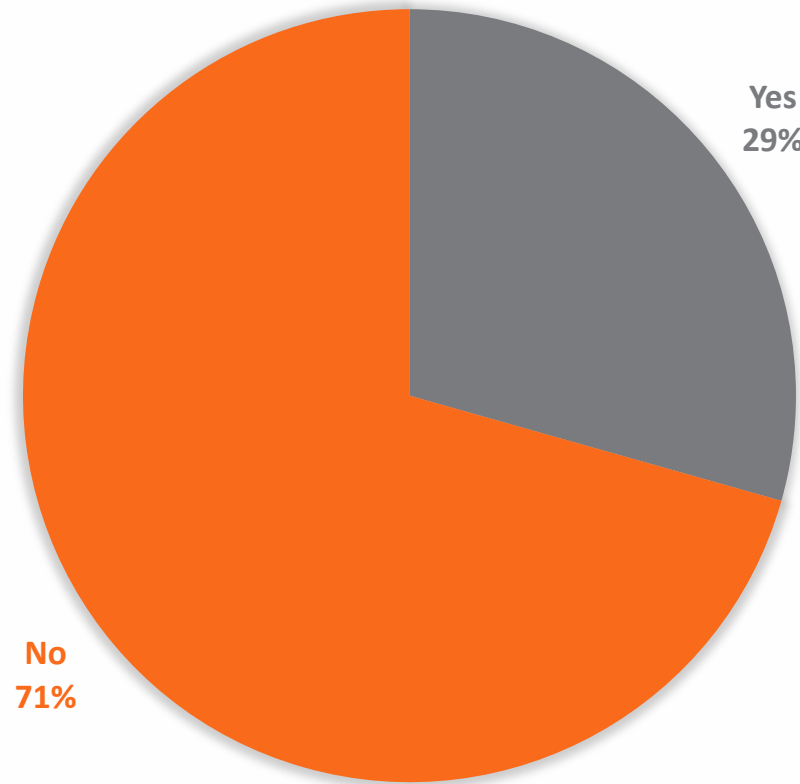

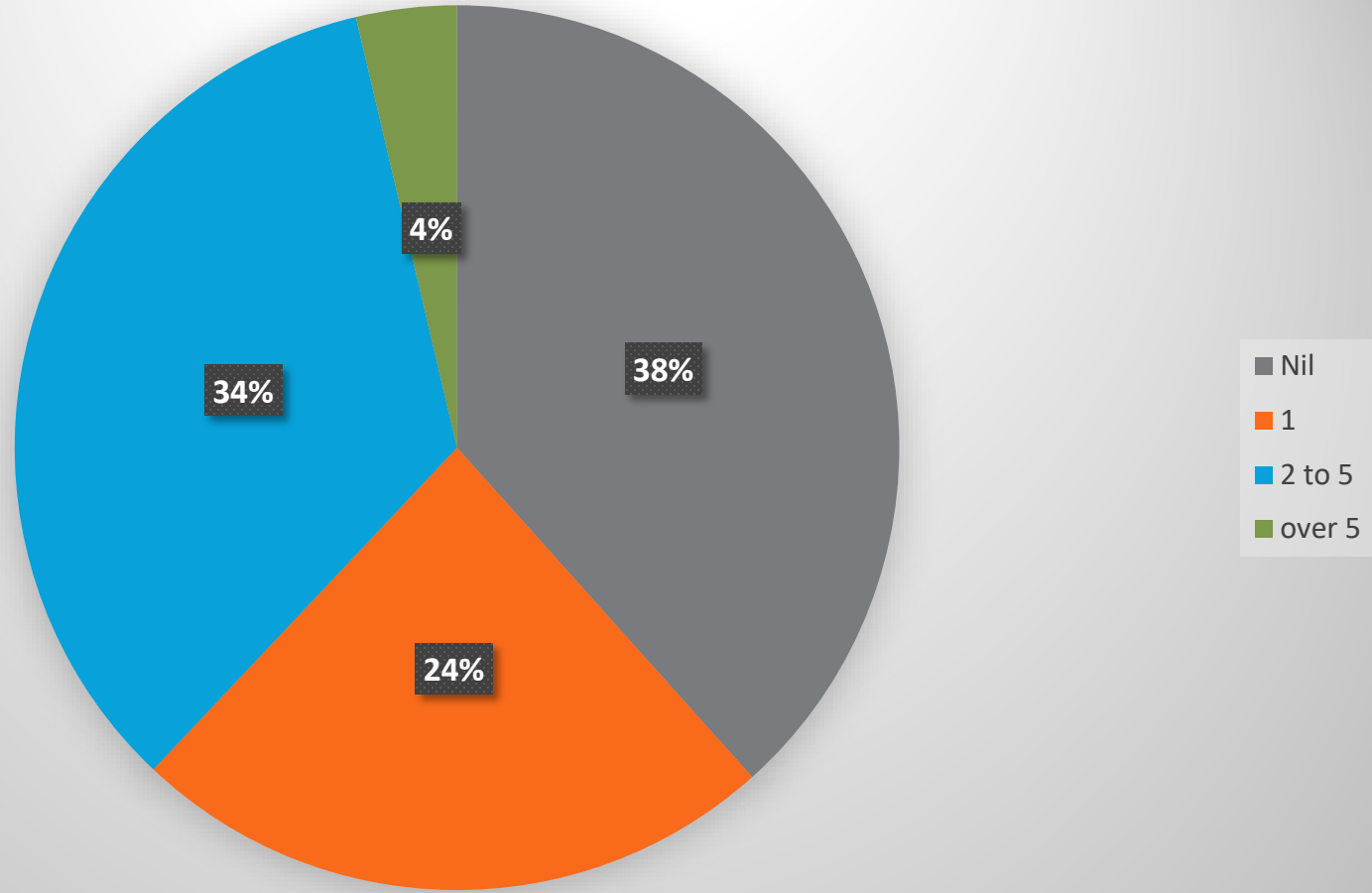
How Often to you encounter substandard Surveys?



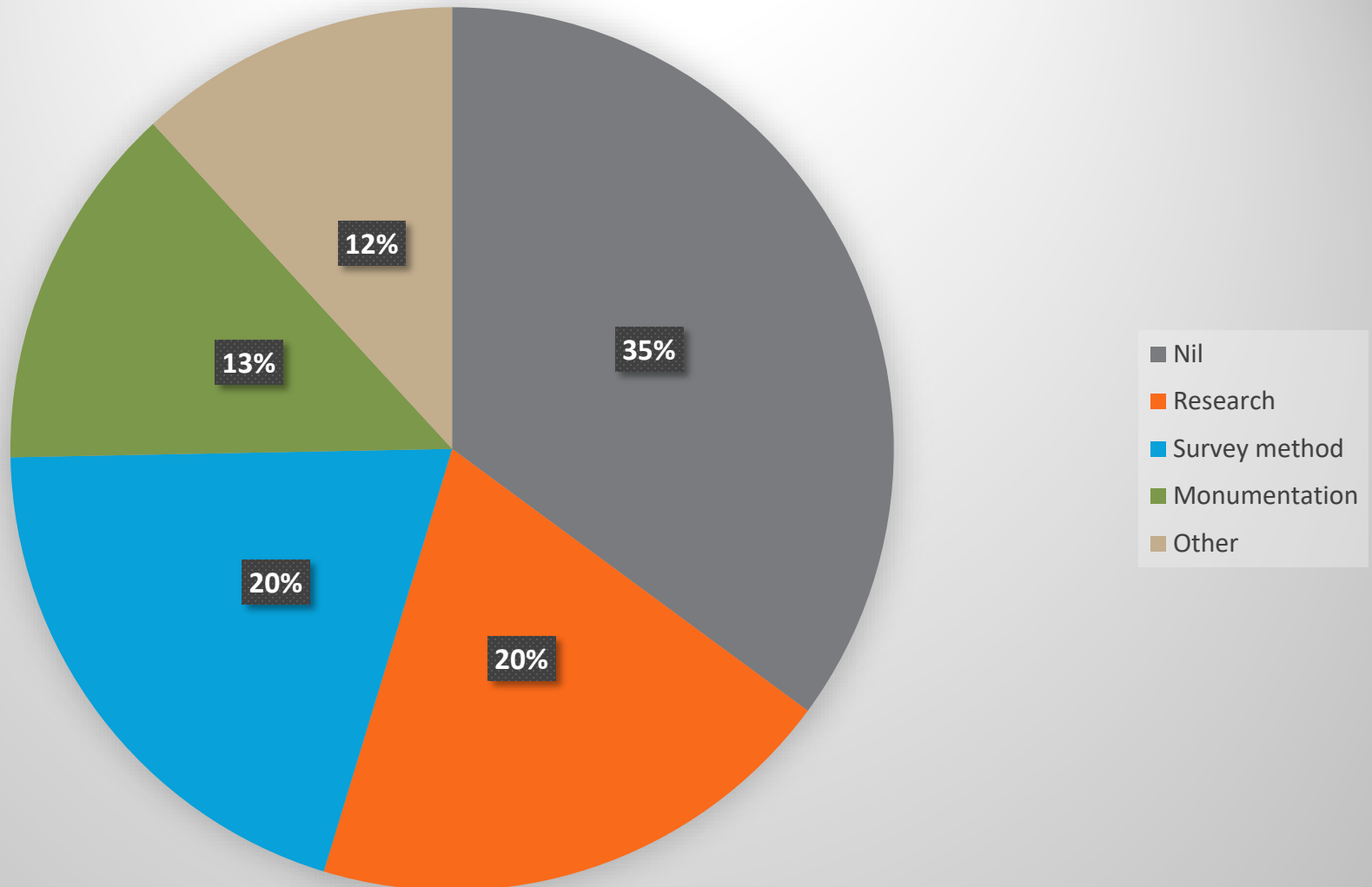
Do you have the impression that surveys without a plan are performed to a lower standard because there is no potential for SRD review?



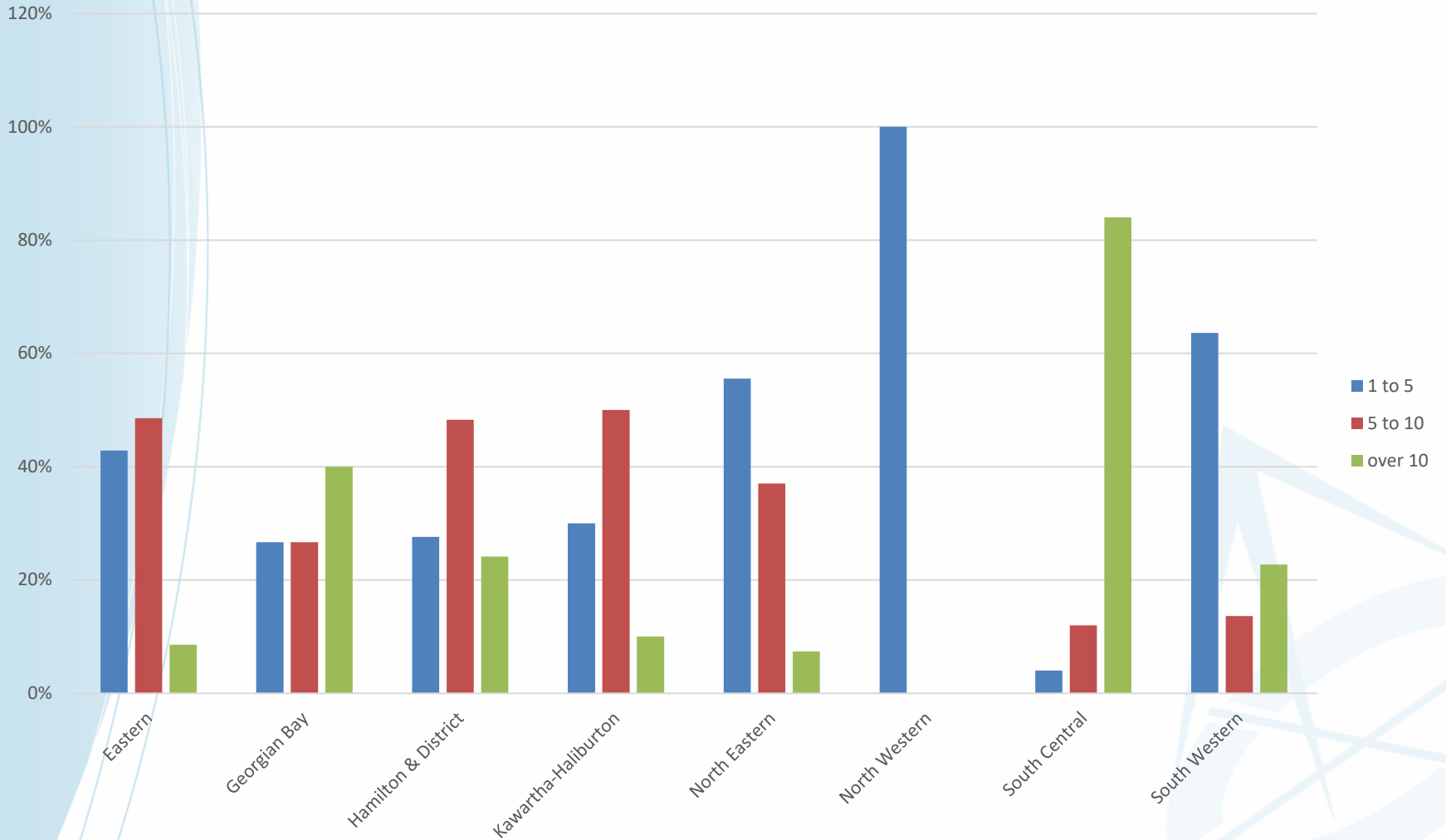
If you have encountered substandard surveys with no plan of survey, how many firms would they be from?



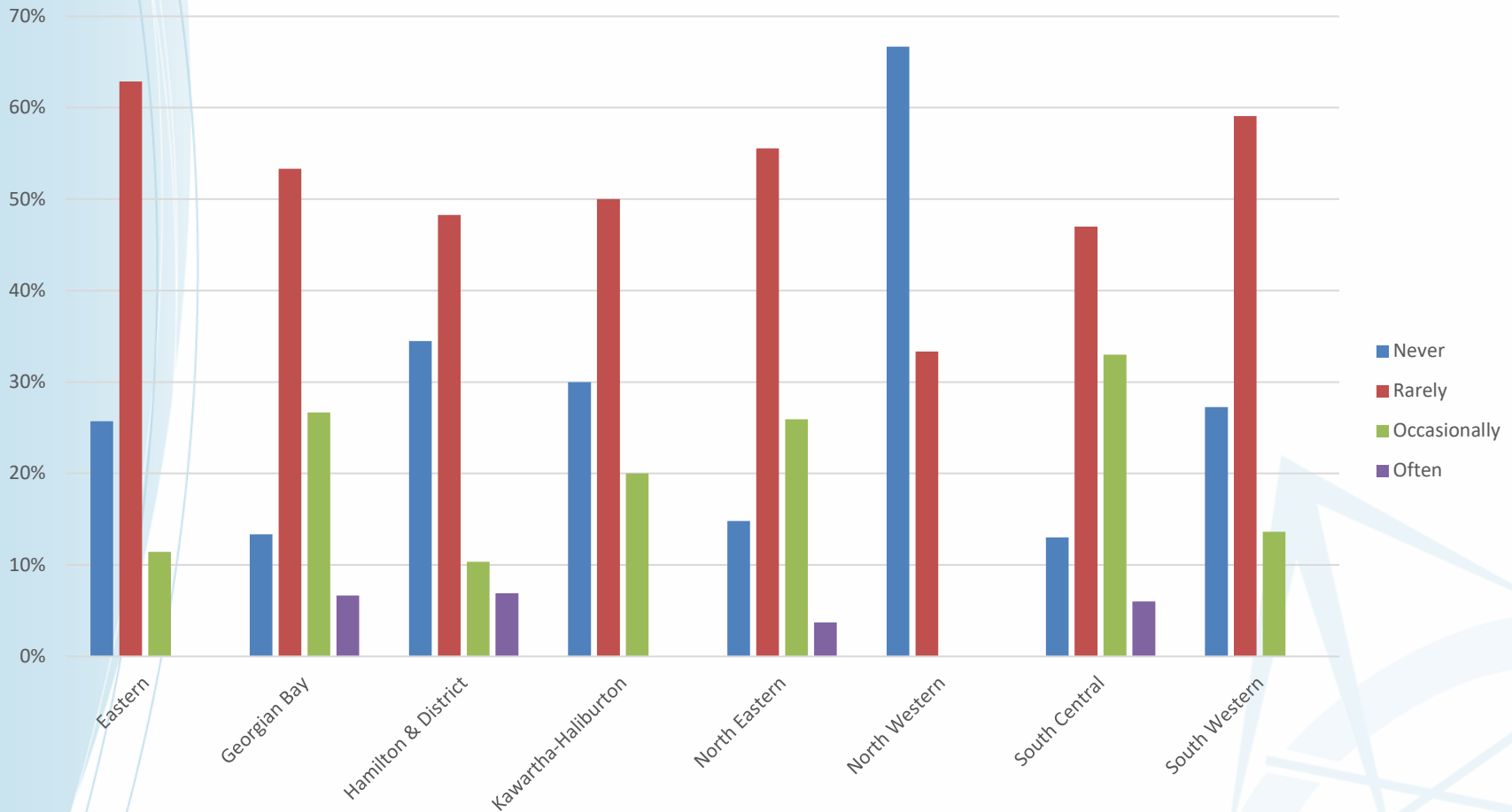
If you have encountered surveys with no plan of survey that you consider substandard, what problems are the most common?



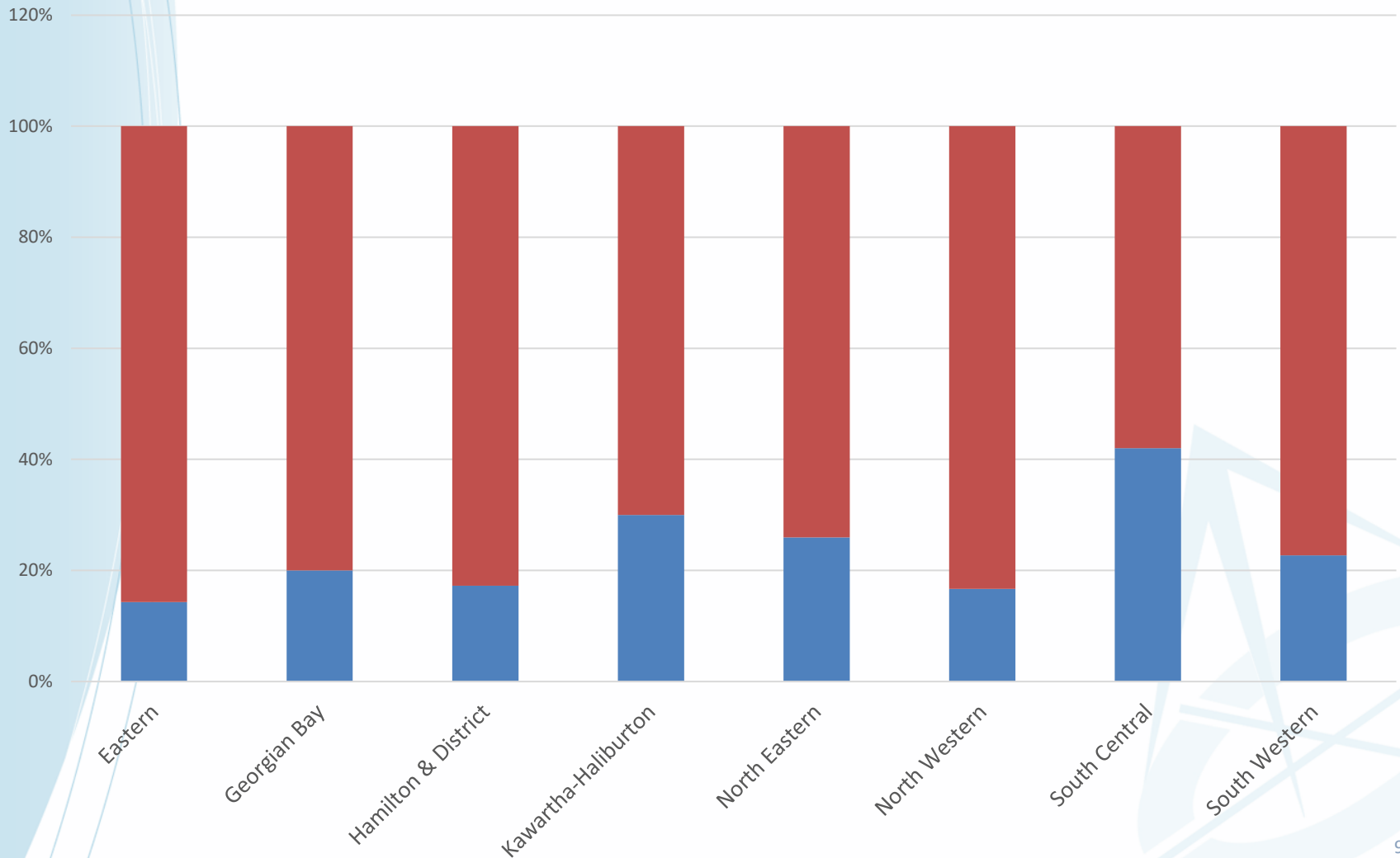
Number of Firms Practicing in Area



How often do you encounter surveys by other surveyors with no plan of survey that you would consider substandard?

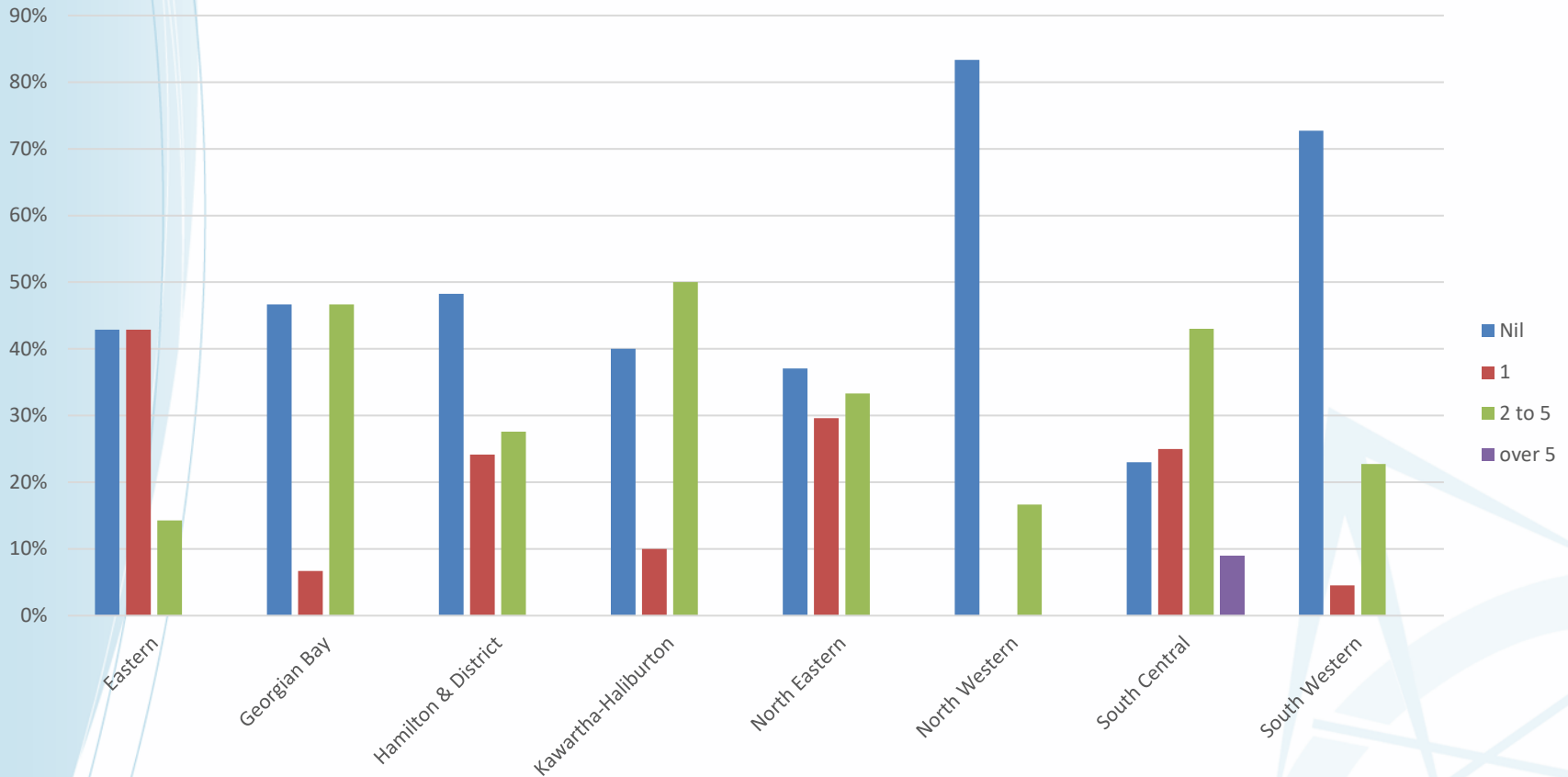

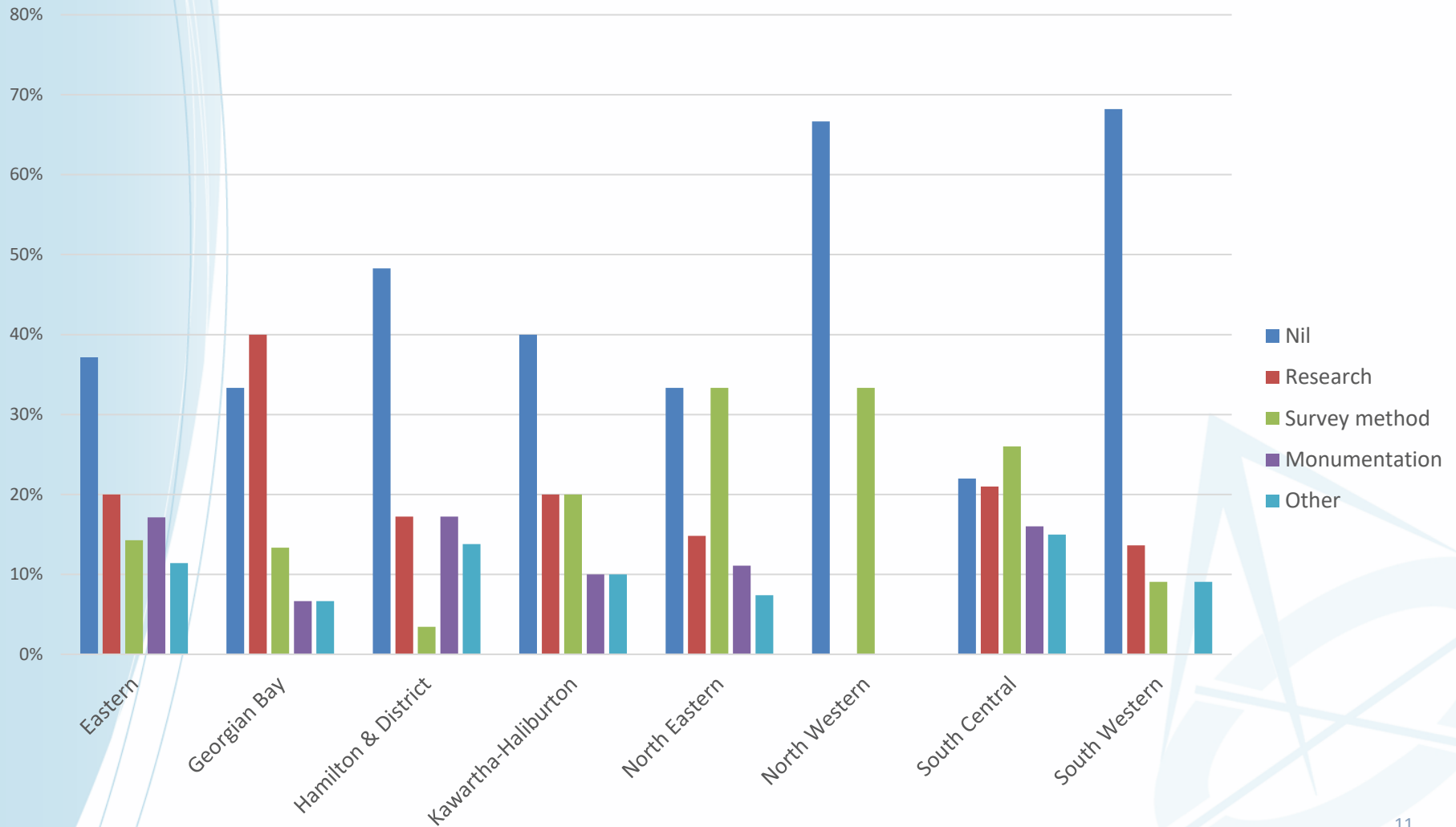


If you have encountered substandard surveys with no plan of survey, how many firms would they be from?

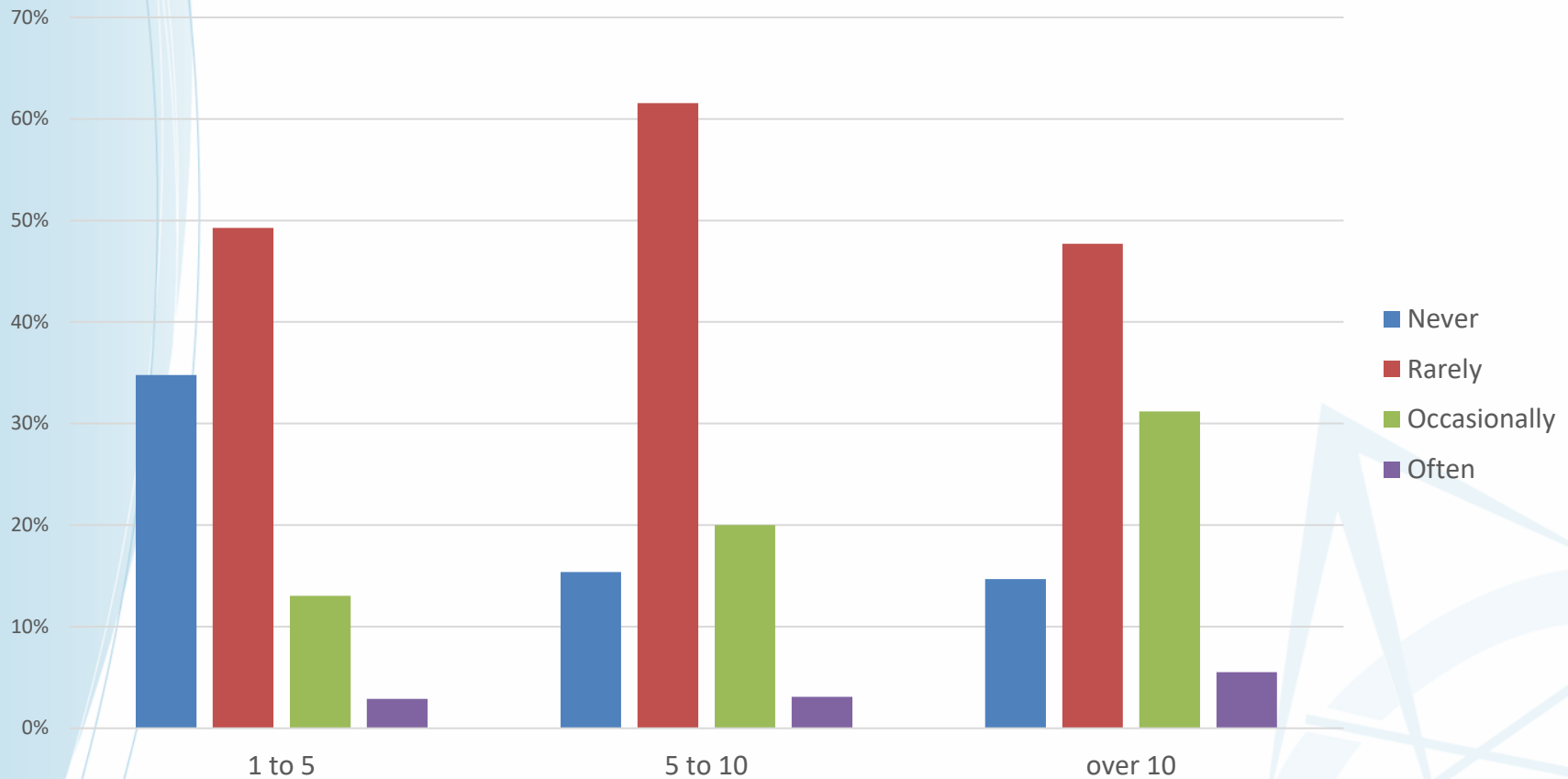

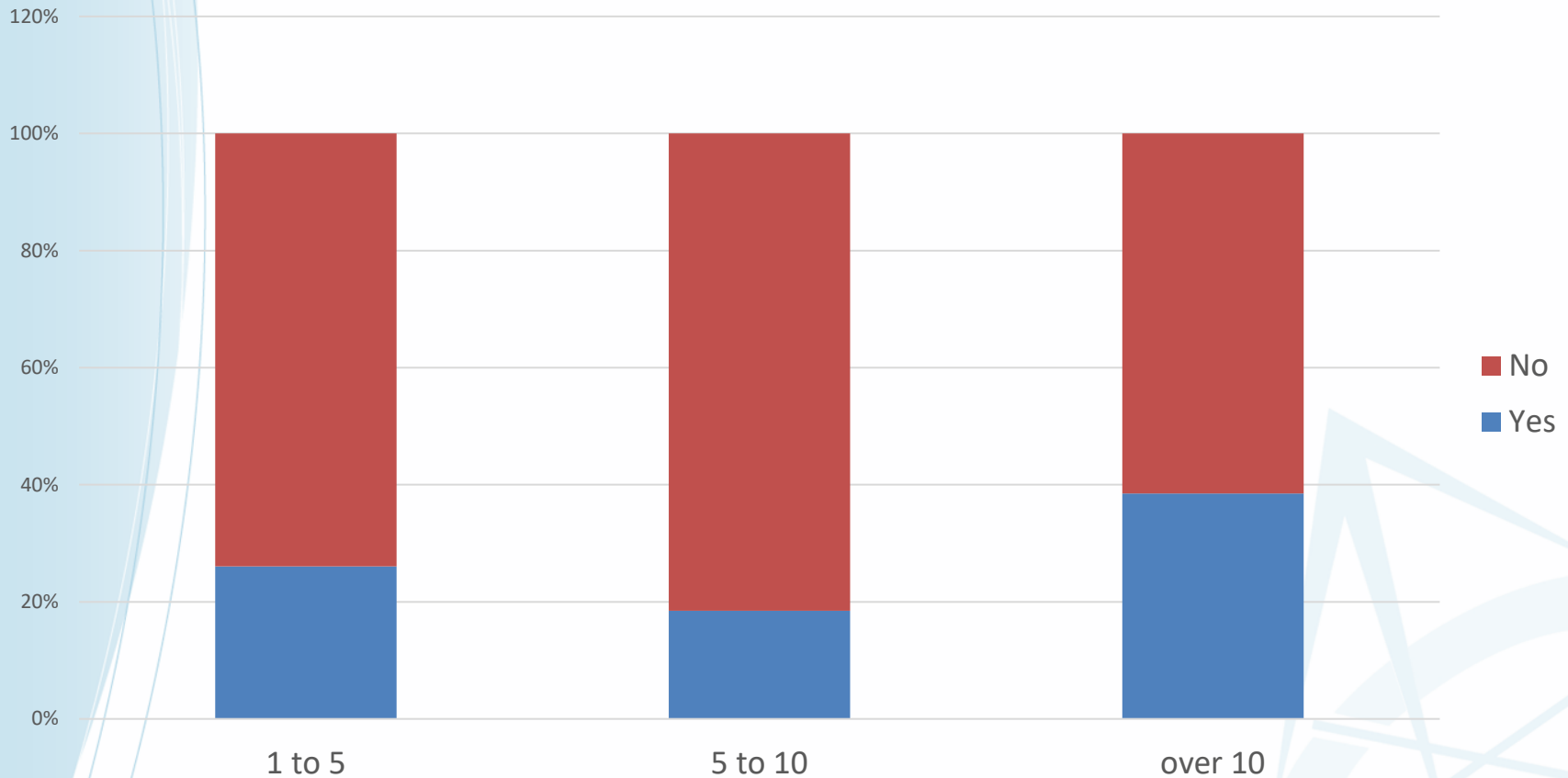
How often do you encounter surveys by other surveyors with no plan of survey that you would consider substandard?

By Number of Firms in Practice Area



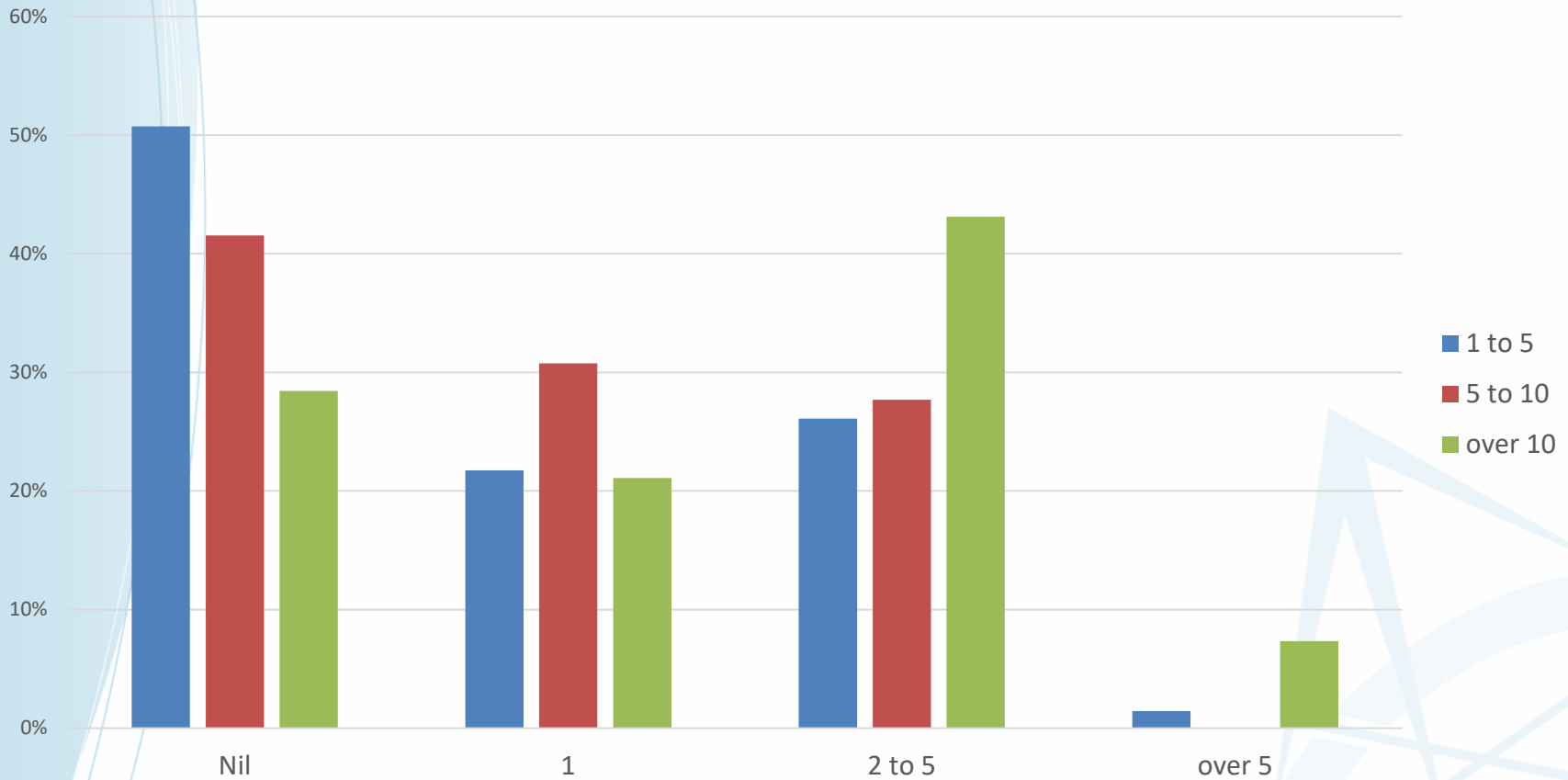

By Number of Firms in Practice Area



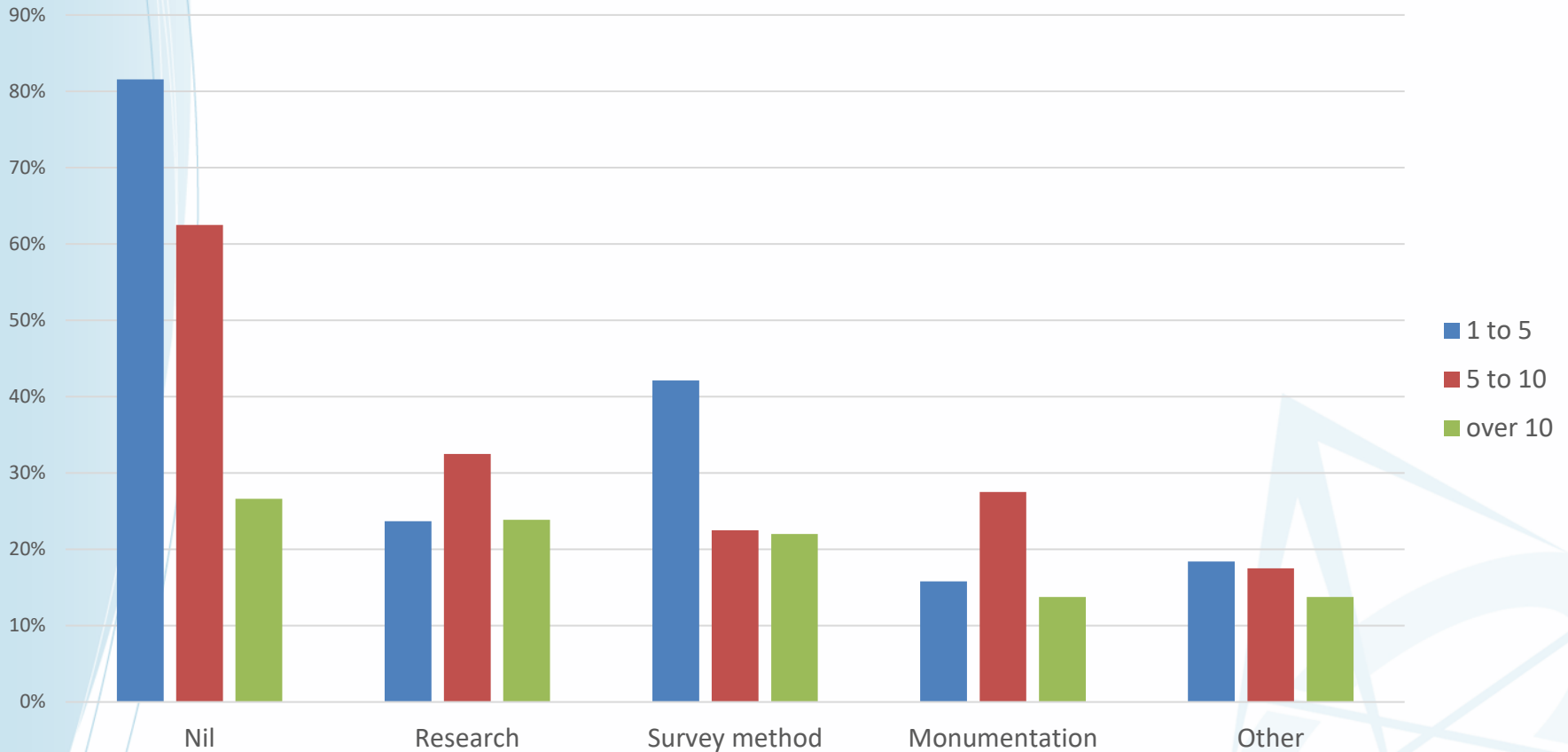
If you have encountered substandard surveys with no plan of survey, how many firms would they be from?

Observations

- We had a good response from across the province (over 50% response rate) so results are statistically significant
- 28% of respondents noted that they occasionally or often ran into problems with surveys without plans prepared (but only 4% were often)
- 29% of respondents felt that surveys performed without the possibility of SRD review were performed to a lower standard
- Deficiencies types were relatively equal with research and monumentation occupying the highest responses at 20% each
- As might be expected areas with more surveyors practicing had higher responses of problems being encountered
- The highest level of problems cited were from South-Central, then Georgian Bay, then North Eastern.
- The lowest level of problems cited were from North Western, then Eastern, then South Western, then Kawartha Haliburton
