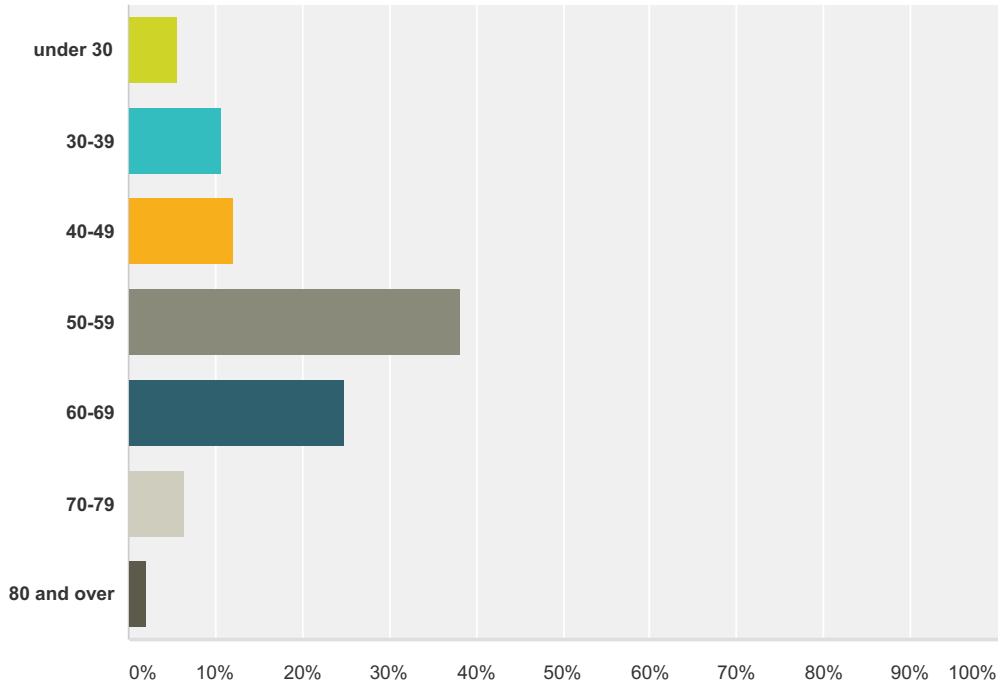

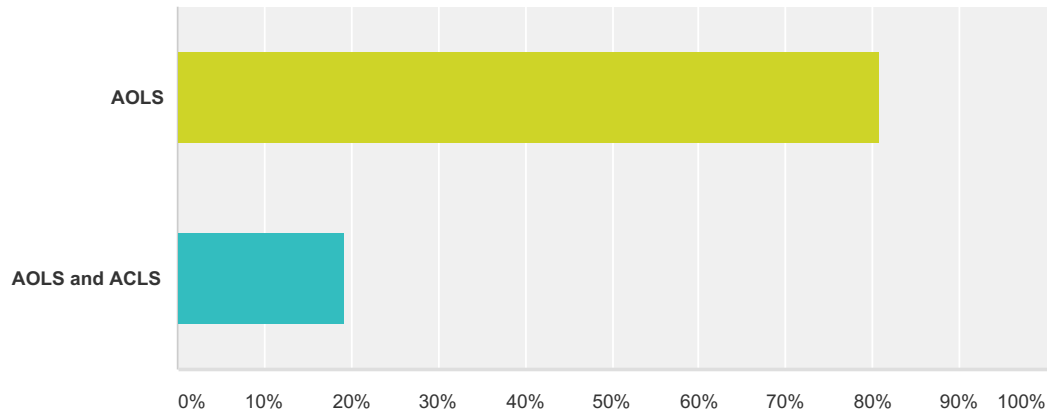

Q4 Association(s) that you belong to

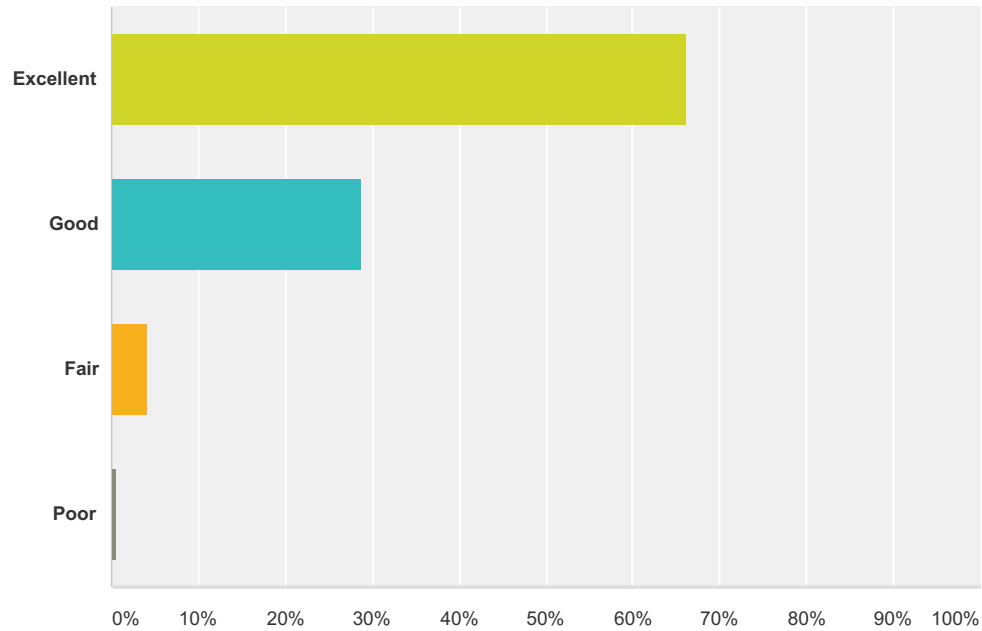

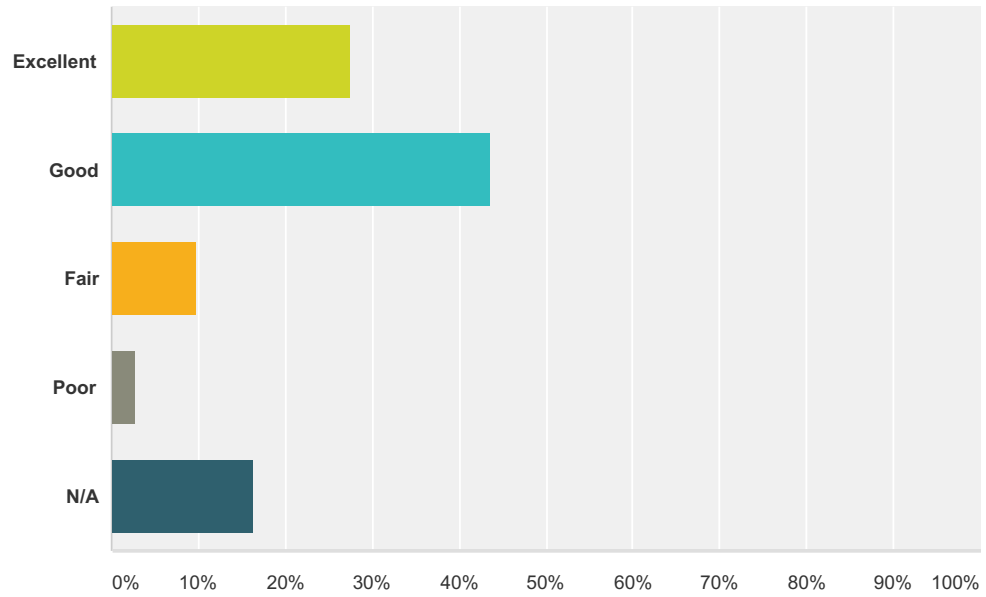

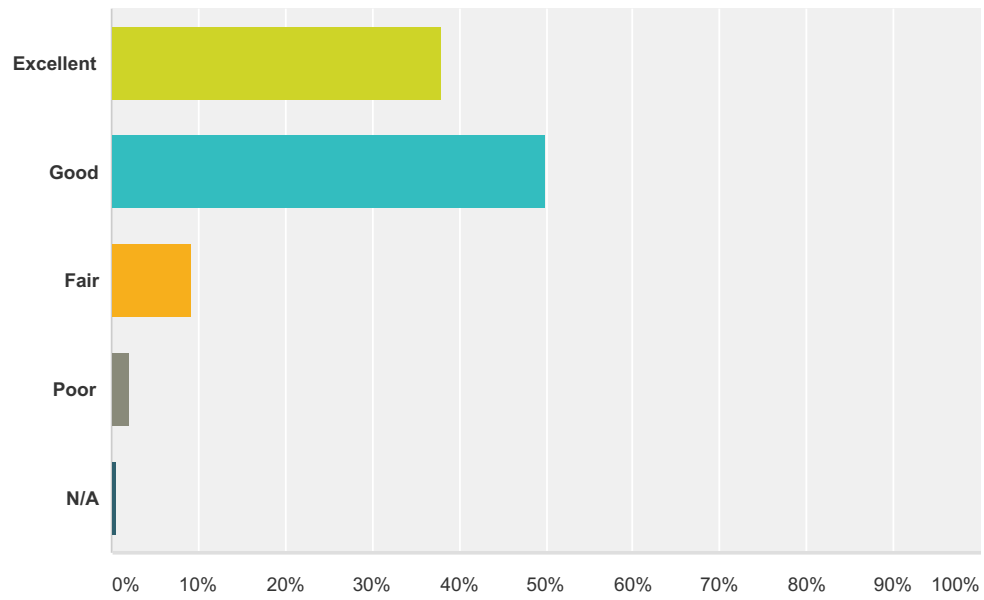

Q7 How would you rate the meeting room for the plenary sessions (the large room)?

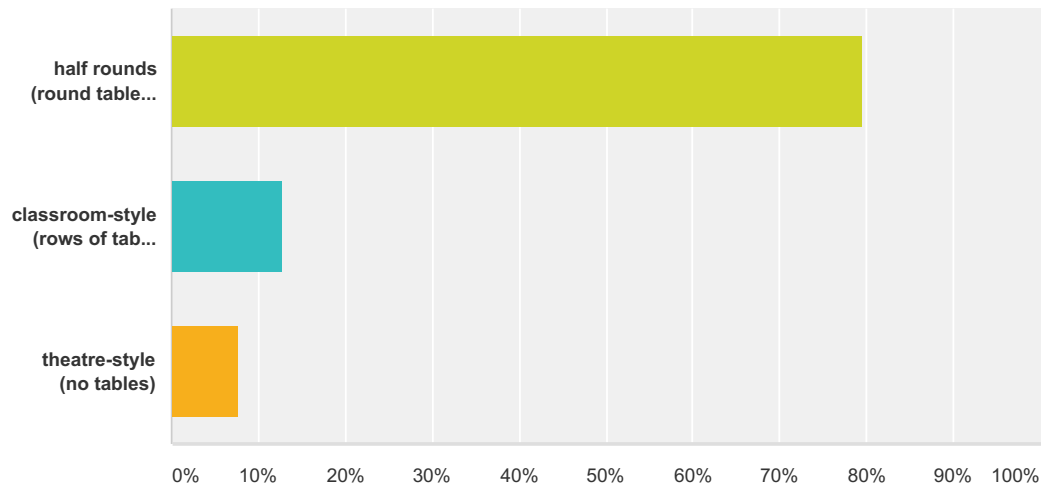

Q8 How do you prefer the room to be set up?

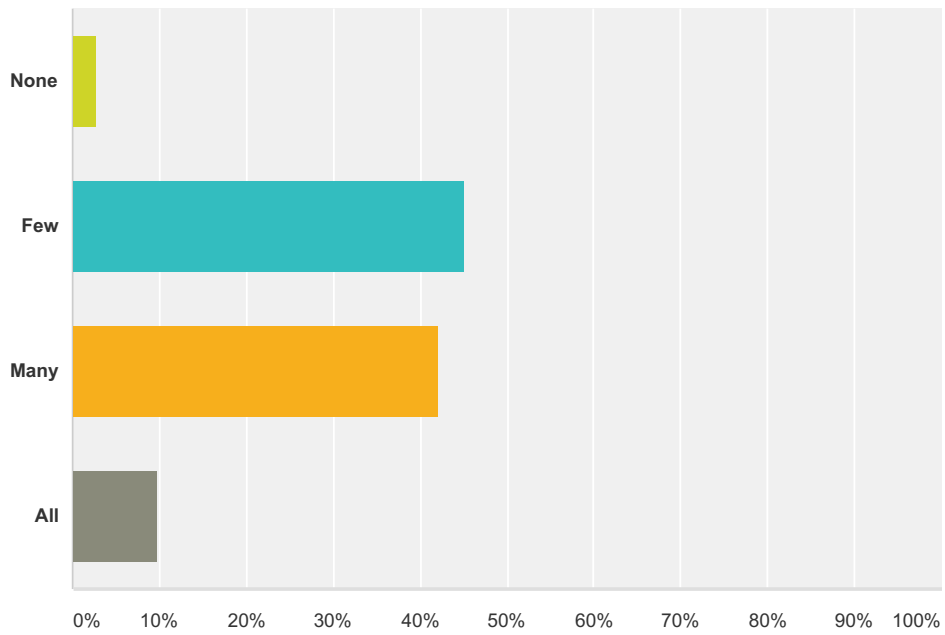

Q9 How many of the 30 exhibitor booths did you visit?

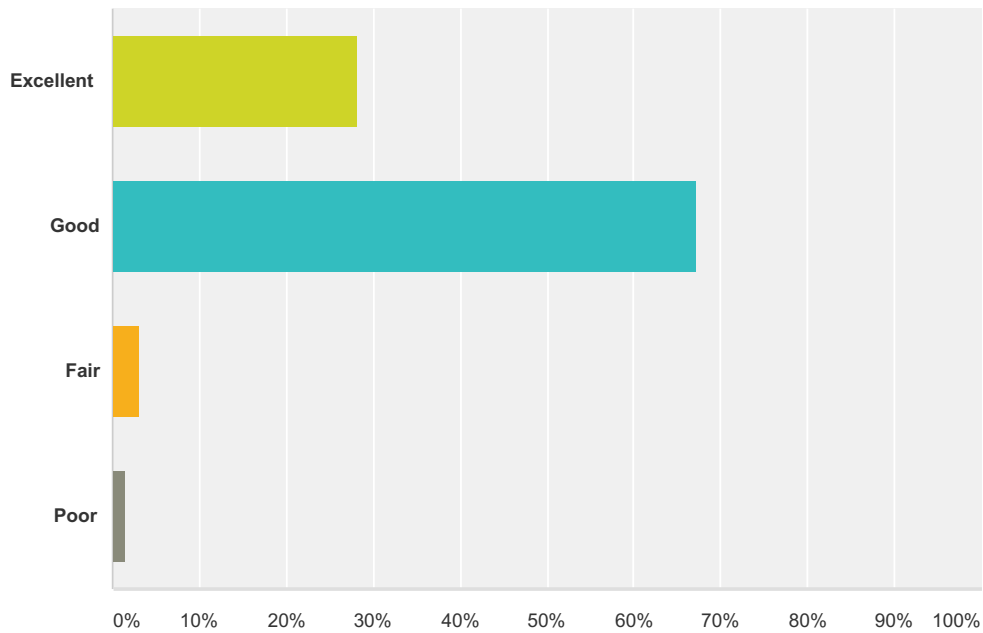

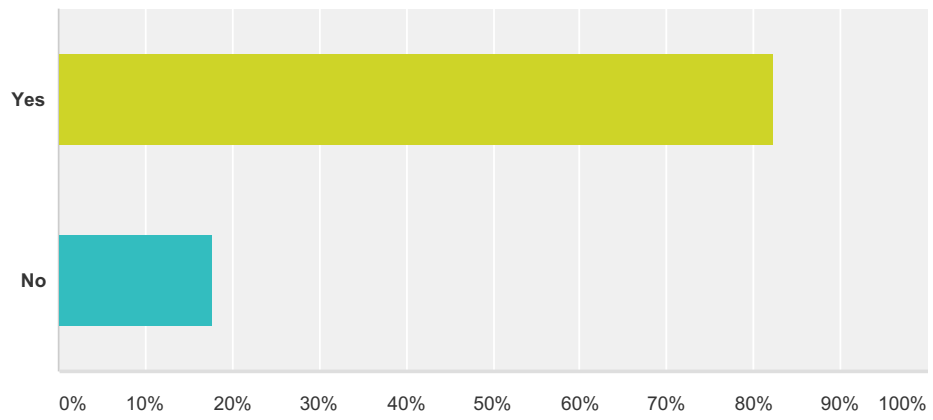

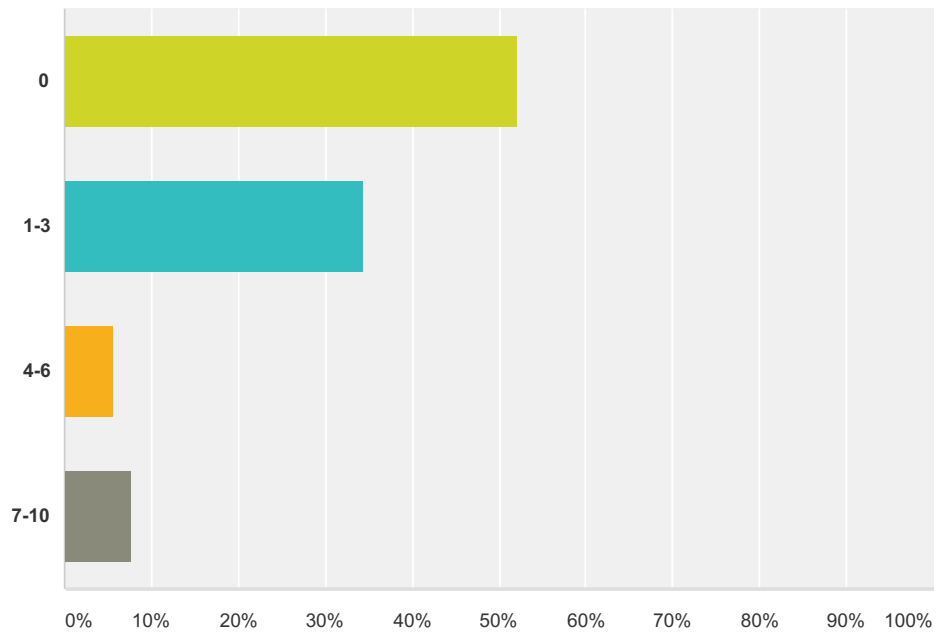
