

ARTHUR BOULTBEE

Arthur Boulton, P.L.S., born August 15th, 1834, a son of Felix and Mary (Samuel Boulton) was a native of Devonshire, England. Coming to Canada with his parents, they lived at Ancaster and he and his brother William were educated at Dr. Tassie's School in Hamilton and later Arthur went to Bishop's College, Lennoxville. Mr. Boulton was apprenticed to J. H. Esten, P.L.S., in Newmarket, and became a P.L. Surveyor on January 10th, 1859, but did not make surveying his life work as afterwards he was a lawyer and in 1870 he became a clergyman, being rector at Cayuga.

In 1861 he married Maria Turner a sister of Frank Turner, who was a well known Engineer of Toronto, for many years. Mr. Boulton died on August 2nd, 1890.

Mr. Boulton's surviving children are Harold F., Ernest K., and Arthur B., of Toronto, Mrs. Effie Turner Vedder, of New York, and Mrs. Rosalind Bell, of Hamilton, Ontario.

In addition, two sons and one daughter died in infancy.
