

John Basil Dodd (No. 996)

1934 - 2009

John B. Dodd was born and raised in the Toronto area. He articulated to Edward Taylor, O.L.S. and began his surveying career working in both Toronto and northern Ontario.

In 1959, having received his commission John moved to Simcoe, Ontario where he entered into an arrangement with H.V. Jewitt, O.L.S. and G. Douglas Vallee, P.Eng. The operating name was Jewitt, Dodd and Vallee. John's main focus at that time was drainage with some cadastral work.

John decided to open his own practise in 1970 and continued to survey until 2007 when health issues emerged and John passed away in 2009.

A long time Rotarian, John was also chair of the South-West Regional Group and an avid curler.

John is survived by his wife Margaret, son Geoff two daughters Jocelyn and Cheryl and four grandchildren.
