W. L. "DUTT" DUTTON, O.B.E.

Mr. Dutton had an extensive career in the gas industry, retiring as General Manager of United Gas Limited, Hamilton, in 1974.

He had an outstanding military record, serving in the Canadian Militia from 1927 to 1940. During World War II he served in England, Italy and Northwest Europe on Brigade and Divisional Staffs and completed his active military career as Lieutenant Colonel of the 5th Canadian Division. He was Commanding Officer of the Kent Regiment in Chatham from 1946 to 1958. His decorations included the E.D. for Efficiency and the O.B.E. as an Officer of the British Empire.

He was Immediate Past President and a Director of the Hamilton Automobile Club since 1968, a Past Director and a Member of the Rotary Club of Hamilton since 1955, a Member of the Regional Land Division Committee since 1973, a Member of the Board of Directors of Chedoke Hospital and a long standing Board Member of the Dundas Valley School of Art.

He was a resident in the Town of Dundas for a number of years and leaves a wife Emily and six children.
