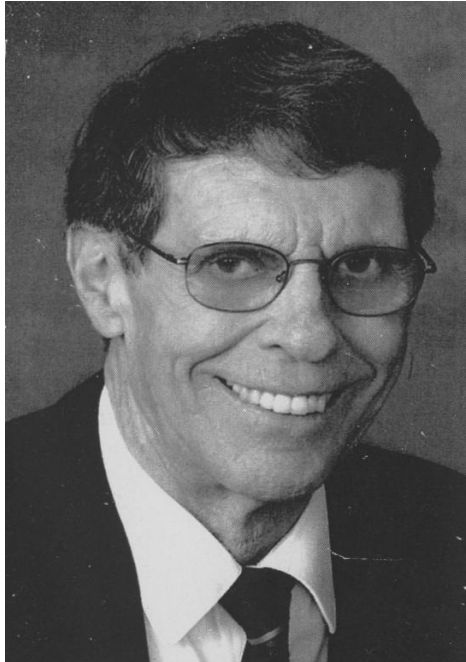


**Clare William Allan Jones, O.L.S.
August 12, 1933 – May 24, 2008**

Clare was born in Barrie, Ontario. He was the third child of a family of 4. He attended Prince of Wales Public School in Barrie and played baseball on the school team. He attended Barrie District Collegiate Institute, where he played football and enjoyed playing trombone as a member of the high school band.

Following graduation he began his career in surveying with James Diamond, O.L.S., in Barrie. He continued his studies, completed his articles and was commissioned as an Ontario Land Surveyor on July 16th, 1958. He continued working with James Diamond. During this time they surveyed many of the new and re-

constructed roads in Simcoe County. Clare took over the practice when James passed away in 1966 and continued with his practice in Barrie for 31 years, from 1966 until he retired in 1997. He had in his files the records of the late Arthur G. Ardagh, O.L.S. and the late Henry Creswicke, Jr., P.L.S. Clare was a thorough and dedicated land surveyor.

Following retirement he played golf and curled with the seniors at the Barrie Curling Club until 2003 when he was diagnosed with Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease. He passed away on May 24th, 2008, the month following our 53rd wedding anniversary. Clare was a very private person, but with a good sense of humour. He was a loving husband, father and grandfather and is greatly missed.
