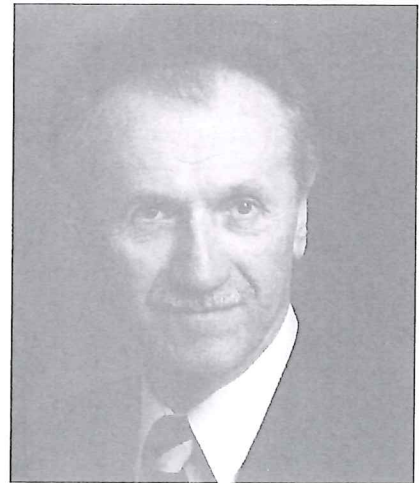


**PETER PAVLIN, O.L.S.**  
**December 4<sup>th</sup> 1926 – July 13<sup>th</sup> 2003**

Peter was born in Ljubljana, Slovenia and attended the State High School where he graduated in 1947. He attended the University of Graz, Austria and majored in Chemical Engineering. After completing a contract as a lumberjack-labourer in Kapuskasing, Ontario, he attended the University of Western Ontario in London. He articulated with Mr. Harold Howden, O.L.S. and was commissioned as an Ontario Land Surveyor in May 1962.



He worked his way through university as a gardener, chauffeur, painter, cook, salesman, dishwasher, car-jockey, TV aerial installer and waiter.

Peter worked for the Department of Highways as a Surveyor-supervisor and then for the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations in their legal department as a Survey Examiner. He was a Senior Land Surveyor with Public Works Canada from 1975 until his retirement in 1995. He was an Ontario Land Surveyor for 41 years.

He was a veteran of the Slovenian Civil War (Domobranci) and among his many contributions to the community he was a member of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, a Past Grand Knight of the Knights of Columbus and a Knight of Malta. Peter brought an "Old World" European approach to his life in Canada. He was cultured, refined, and appreciative of the best things that life had to offer; he enjoyed the outdoors, the arts and cherished his family.

Peter died peacefully in Toronto with his family by his side on the afternoon of Sunday, July 13<sup>th</sup> 2003 at the age of 76 years. He was the beloved husband of 47 years to Stefanie. Loving father of the late Gregory, Peter Jr. and his wife Belina, and his daughter Teresa and the proud Papa of his grandchildren Steven and David. He leaves his sister Anica and many relatives and friends in Slovenia. He will be sadly missed by his family.
