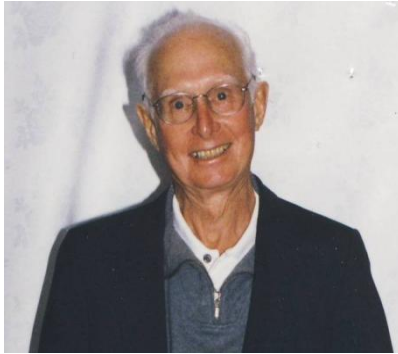


**Richard (Dick) H. Ross, OLS #1070  
1922 – 2011**
