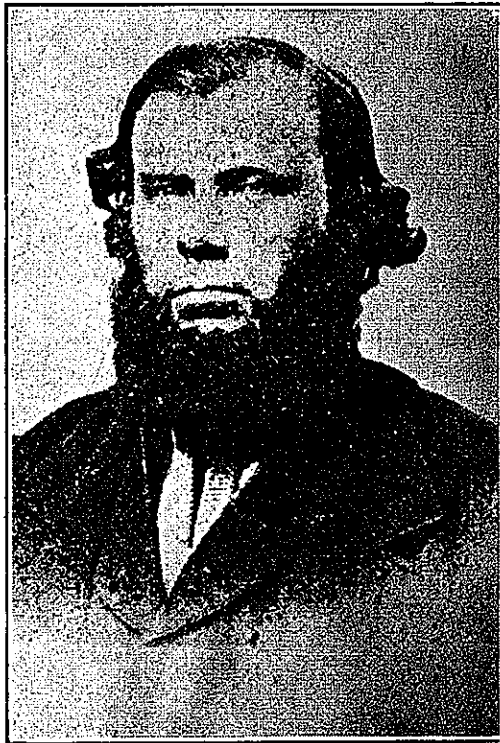


### A. B. SCOTT

John Scott of Aberdeen, Scotland, emigrated to Canada about 1830, and settled at Brampton, Upper Canada, where he married Mary Lynch, who came from the United States.

They had the following children:— (1) Andrew Brown,



born at Brampton on August 5th, 1835, the subject of this Sketch. (2) Alex. F., Judge, County of Peel. (3) David Lynch, born 1845. Practised law at Orangeville where he was Mayor 1879-1880, then went to Regina, Mayor in 1883; was one of Crown Counsel in trial of Louis Riel, 1885; in 1894 appointed judge, and subsequently Chief Justice of Alberta; died at Cooking Lake near Edmonton July 26th, 1924. (4) William H., at one time M.P. for Peterborough, Ontario. (5) Mary Catharine, married John Coyne, M.P.P. for Peel. (6) Elizabeth Margaret.

Andrew B. Scott, served his apprenticeship with Charles Unwin of Toronto, and qualified as a P.L.S. on April 13th, 1858. He practised at Brampton.

In 1865, he was at Petrolia during the oil boom.

In November, 1865, he married Margaret E. Campbell, who was born on May 8th, 1840.

Their children were as follows:—(1) John Robert, died in infancy. (2) Seth Andrew, born June 13th, 1869, now living in Brampton. (3) Mary Elizabeth, born April 22nd, 1871, died July 15th, 1923. (4) Ellen Margaret, born December 10th, 1874. (5) Prudence Sophia, born June 9th, 1876. (6) Alexander Campbell, born September 9th, 1878.

A. B. Scott was Captain of No. 1 Company, 36th Battalion of infantry; public school trustee; Town Clerk; Secretary of Agricultural Society, and also owned a farm.

In the Masonic order, he took 3rd degree, St. John's Lodge in 1859, Royal Arch Mason 1861, and was afterwards W.M. of Ionic Lodge, Brampton.

His death occurred at his home in Brampton on November 28th, 1877.
