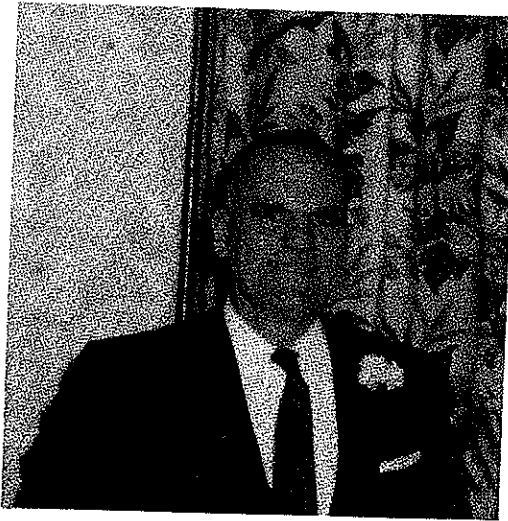

WILLIAM ALEXANDER SEAWRIGHT O.L.S.  
1904 – 1973

William Alexander Seawright was born in Banbridge, Ireland, on March 12, 1904. He served his articles with the firm of Speight and Van Nostrand of Toronto and was commissioned as an Ontario Land Surveyor in 1926. In 1933 he joined the Surveys Branch of the Department of Highways of Ontario, and subsequently surveyed in many parts of the Province. In 1956 he was appointed Chief Inspector of Surveys, Field which position he held until his retirement in 1964.

During his retirement Bill divided his time between his winter home in Englewood, Florida, and his summer home in Muskoka. Leisure time was spent with his "ham" radio, boating and fishing and in a variety of building projects.

William Alexander Seawright who passed away on October 22nd, 1973, is survived by his wife, the former Ruth Noble, of Barrie, a brother Thomas H. Seawright of Anten Mills, a sister Florence McKee of Elmvale, and son Terrence Barry Seawright of Cambridge.
