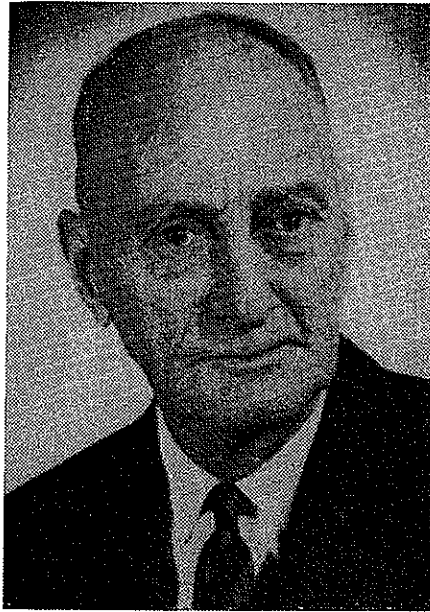


REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON BIOGRAPHY AND REPOSITORY



WILLIAM SELWYN WINTERS, O.L.S., B.A.Sc., P.Eng.

1891 - 1966

The year 1966 has claimed another old gentlemen of our profession, William (Bill) S. Winters, who passed away suddenly on October 10, 1966, at the age of 75. His wise counsel, even temperament and good nature will be greatly missed.

Bill was born on January 23, 1891, in the City of Toronto. He attended Jarvis Collegiate and then went to the University of Toronto, graduating with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering in the year 1913 along with his friend W. F. (Weary) Beatty. Bill was elected class secretary for his year and has enjoyed many hours arranging reunions over the past years.

In 1914, he articulated to Speight, van Nostrand, Ward & Anderson, Ontario Land Surveyors, and received his commission on March 16, 1915.

He worked for a time on the New Welland Ship Canal and in 1916 married Elizabeth Gordon.

In 1920 he went into private practice forming a partnership with Edward Ireson which lasted till 1926 when Ed. left to go with Ontario Hydro. Bill continued the business. Bill remained in private practice until his retirement in 1963 taking two more partners after the war, R. Gordon Maughan, and George Glenday.

He was a member of the Granite Club and St. Leonard's Anglican Church. He is survived by his wife and only daughter, Joy, and a sister Jean.
